Thank you for your letter of 23 March to the Foreign Secretary on behalf of your constituent Ms Jayne Owens about a request for help with her partner, Mr Gary Owens' compensation case in Spain. I am replying as Minister responsible for our relations with Spain.

As you may know, the Foreign and Commonwealth Office is not able to interfere in the legal systems of other countries, just as they are unable to interfere in ours. Consular staff are not legally trained and Mr Owens' lawyer is best placed to advise him on legal matters. We maintain a list of English speaking lawyers in Spain on the gov.uk website, which your constituent and her partner may find helpful if they wish to appoint different legal representation.

Consular officers in Malaga may be able to express concern to the courts over the length of time Mr Owens' claim is taking to process. Should Mr Owens wish consular officials to take this forward he can contact Jacqueline Featherston on 0034 952 352300 or by email at spain.consulate@fco.gov.uk giving permission for officials to contact his lawyer and the court to find out the status of his case.

Dear Ms. Owens,

Further to your emails in relation to Mr. Gary Owen's case and the Spanish Judiciary system, our apologies for not having been able to reply sooner. As I believe you are aware the Spanish Judicial system can be very slow and sometimes frustrating.

Whilst we sympathise with your situation, the British Consulate staff are not legally trained or in fact have a legal section that could advise or intervene in these matters; nor is it our role. We are unable to become involved in specific cases or investigate particular cases. However, I can now confirm that in this instance, we have been able to speak with Malaga Audiencia Provincial courthouse, "Seccion 1a" who are the courthouse mentioned in the paperwork you sent us, that the Spanish Ministry of Justice requested apply for the necessary information from Marbella Instruction court No 4 in relation to Mr. Owen's case. In spite of data protection, the Malaga Audiencia Provincial court did agree to check on the progress of this matter. The Audiencia Provincial de Malaga, Seccion 1a Court whilst unable to discuss the specifics of the case told us that to date they have not received a request from the Spanish Ministry of Justice, consequently they have not requested any papers from Marbella.

Malaga Audiencia Provincial courthouse suggested that we inform your lawyer Mr. Luis Tatay Lopez, so that if he felt it necessary he could pursue this matter. We have now spoken to Mr. Luis Tatay Lopez, we have relayed your concerns to him and he has confirmed to us that he continues to monitor this matter with the Spanish Judiciary system which is extremely slow and still likely to take further time to resolve. He also confirmed that he is in regular contact with you.

I trust that this reply will be of some help to you.
